As one of these entities, your Draft 2019 Water Use Plan ("Plan") is enclosed. Any necessary revisions or updates are typically associated with the following items when applicable:

- Newly approved water rights or change applications
- Lapsing, withdrawn, replaced, or terminated water rights and/or applications
- Changes in number of shares or exchange contracts
- Newly approved point of diversion (POD), measuring locations, and/or conveyance facilities (ditches, pipelines, etc.)
- Water right ownership updates, contractual agreements, resumption of use, etc.
- Compliance with all applicable limitations and conditions of approval associated with each water right

Your 2019 Plan is an important part of the operation of the Weber River Distribution System operated by the Weber River Commissioner and Deputy Commissioner under the direction of the Utah Division of Water Rights. The Plan does not necessarily identify all the applicable use limits, but it must comply with them. Such limits include quantity changes, point of diversion (POD) locations, applicable contracts or agreements, sources, type of use, return flow criteria, place of use, priority date, ownership, supplemental rights, etc.

Subject: 2019 Water Use Plan

Your diversions are metered and/or measured and reported by the Weber River Water Commissioner and/or Deputy Commissioner using measuring devices required under state water law. Water users are responsible for maintaining lockable control valves or gates and reliable measuring devices at each POD where water is diverted. Water users are also responsible for maintaining contracts relating to any approved Water Right "exchange" or "change" applications approved by this office for use, as set forth under conditions of approval when applicable.

If your water rights or water contracts change, your Plan must be updated. It is your responsibility to amend your Plan as soon as possible whenever such changes occur.

Please review the Draft Plan and submit your 2019 Plan to the Utah Division of Water Rights (attn: Ben Anderson) via US Mail at the address below before January 10, 2019.
