RE: New hydrographic survey map prepared for each of these rights


The bottom line up front: The attached map is slightly different from maps previously on file, and it depicts the adjudicated place of use for two irrigation groups, Group 417285 for 20 acres, and Group 416389 for 28.78 acres.

In preparation for the publication of the Dry Creek Proposed Determination, the place of use for each water use group was reviewed resulting in slight modifications to the Hydrographic Survey. A new map depicting the place of use of water rights 57-2526, 57-69, and 57-10496 is attached.

The federal reserved right (57-10496) is a right for the irrigation of 20 acres of land comprising the 20 acres set apart from the Camp Douglas reservation for use as a cemetery. These 20 acres are represented by Water Use Group 417285. (Other water rights are party to this group, but water right 57-10496 contains the sole supply.) The attached map is intended to show the authorized place of use is the same as the original 20 acres set apart, having never been changed.

The remaining water rights associated with Mount Olivet, 57-69 and 57-2526, are also party to another group, Water Use Group 416389, which is depicted as irrigating 28.78 acres. Of these 28.78 acres, 13.94 acres are within Section 4, while 14.84 acres are within Section 9.

(In the proposed determination, which is to be published soon, Water Use Group 416389 also contains other water rights, 57-8855 and 57-8865, which contribute to make a group total of 62.29 acres, but their 33.51 acres are not depicted in the Hydrographic Survey Map, as these two rights were not found in use for the irrigation of the cemetery land.)
