Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Chairman, Daryl Devey at 1:30 pm.

Hearing the 2015 Minutes

A motion was made by Jeff Budge to approve the minutes of the Annual Meeting held on January 20, 21015. The motion was seconded by Mr. Jones.

The motion passed unanimously.

Hearing the 2015 Commissioner's Report

Mr. Roberts distributed copies of the 2015 Annual Report. He also distributed the "Summary of 2015" and the "Data Summary for Water Year November 1 to October 31" from the annual report. Mr. Roberts reviewed these two pages in detail. Copies of these two pages are attached and are made a part of these minutes with this reference. Mr. Roberts also reviewed the 2015 Annual Report.

Mr. Roberts expressed appreciation for the cooperation and help to make the river work as smoothly as it does. He stated that over the years he has served as the Commissioner, he appreciates everyone for their help, including the members of this Board, and for the way that he has been treated. He also expressed appreciation to thank Alan, Deputy Commissioner, for his help.

Mr. Budge moved that the Commissioner's report be accepted. The motion was seconded by Mr. Jones. The motion passed unanimously.

#### Recommending a Water Commissioner for the Next Term

Mr. Budge expressed appreciation to Mr. Roberts for his work on the river system. Mr. Devey and Mr. Bryant both agreed with Mr. Budge's comments. After much discussion, the Board would like to keep Mr. Roberts as the Commissioner for this upcoming year and then we would like to advertise and hire his replacement commissioner in October of this year. The Board hopes to have a training commissioner by January 1 and keep Mr. Roberts on for the following year to train that commissioner.

#### Report from the Division of Water Rights

Mr. Manning reported on HB258 that was passed in the last legislative session and went into effect on January 1, 2016. This bill made water commissioners State employees and makes sure that they are covered under the State's liability insurance. They also changed the fund type from a private fund to a State fund which had to be done because the commissioners, as State employees, must be paid out of a State fund instead of a private fund. Letters were sent out to the commissioners to explain the changes on their end, and letters were sent out to the committee members to help explain the budgeting changes.

Ms. Odekirk expressed appreciation to Mr. Roberts for all the time and training he has given her.

#### Hearing the 2015 Financial Report

Mr. Manning reviewed the "Provo River Distribution System Trust Fund Financial Statement," a copy is attached and made a part of these minutes by this reference.

A motion was made by Mr. Knight to approve the 2015 Financial Report. The motion was seconded by Mr. Simons. The motion passed unanimously.

#### Reviewing the Delinquent Assessments

Ms. Odekirk reviewed the delinquent assessments. They total \$1,048.44, these except for three are only one year delinquent. The Gines, Walker and T.K. Associates, LLC are two years' delinquent, and it looks like they would qualify for collections if we were to just follow our standard procedure. Most of these are small individual accounts and the State struggles to keep current contact information. Mr. McNeil offered to send contact information to Ms. Odekirk on several of the delinquent accounts listed.

#### Preparing a Budget of Salaries and Other Necessary Expenses

Mr. Devey explained that the Board had reviewed the budget earlier and he provided the proposed 2016 budget to the State. A copy of the proposed budget is attached and made a part of these minutes by this reference.

A motion was made to accept the budget for the Provo River Distribution System Fund at \$162,000 by Mr. Bryant. It was seconded by Mr. McNeil. The motion passed unanimously.

#### Setting the Distribution System Assessment

Mr. Budget made a motion to set the assessment at \$162,000. The motion was seconded by Mr. Simons. The motion passed unanimously.

#### Selecting a new Distribution System Chairman and Committee Members, if Necessary

Mr. Budge made a motion to suspend the rules and put in by acclamation the former officers: Daryl Devey as Chairman, Ken VanWagoner as Vice-Chairman, and Debbie Vanoy as Secretary. The motion was seconded by Mr. Brown. The motion passed unanimously.

#### Other Business

Mr. Budge mentioned that the Board voted to hold an additional committee meeting in September to initiate the hiring process. Mr. Devey reported that the Board wants to get together and review the job description, salary range, etc.

A motion was made to adjourn by Mr. Jones. The motion was seconded by Mr. Budge.

The meeting adjourned at 1:50 pm.

## Summary of 2015

No relief arrived this year to improve the water situation. River flows were still down and the river peaked at 1,379 acre feet on June 3<sup>rd</sup>.

The Central Utah Water Conservancy District chose not to lower the conversion line for water rights in Utah Lake. Thus its system storage on the Provo River was converted to permanent storage by importing water to Utah Lake.

The Provo River Water Users Association exercised its May 1 election giving it 10,000 acre feet. Its allotment to shareholders for the year was 66 percent.

The Olmstead power plant ceased operation after producing power for over 100 years. The contract between Rocky Mountain Power and Central Utah Water Conservancy District ended on September 21. Renovation to the penstocks and new generators are in the planning stage and will be installed by Central Utah Water Conservancy District. Until a new plant is in operation water required in the river downstream of the Olmstead diversion dam will be bypassed.

The transfer pumps, to put water in the Salt Lake Aqueduct from the Olmstead flow line, were operated from January 7, 2015 through March 8, 2015. Thus minimum releases from Deer Creek Reservoir for flow in the river were maintained during this period.

The Timpanogos (Utah Valley) diversion dam matter remains unresolved. However, the involved irrigation companies were able to get their water and solutions continue to be discussed.

Irrigation season began in Utah Valley on April 29 and class A rights were delivered at 100 percent until September 16. Rights were reduced to 75 percent from September 16 through September 30. Some secondary rights were delivered from May 1 through June 16.


