INTERLOCUTORY JUDGMENT AND DECREE

Civil No. 7822

This matter having come before the Court for hearing on or about the 15th day of February, 1961, on the 29th day of May, 1963, and again on the 9th day of July, 1963, on the protests of the George Creek Irrigation Company and Orville E. Taylor, to the Proposed Determination of Water Rights submitted by the State Engineer as to George Creek, Johnson Creek and tributaries in Box Elder County; and the Court having heard the evidence offered by the respective parties and being fully advised in the premises finds the water rights awarded to each party herein are fully supported by the evidence as to quantities of water dates of priority, and to the extent of use upon the lands of the parties herein; except that certain water user's claims of Orville Taylor should be increased to include an additional 100 head of cattle and that the priority rights to the use of water from George Creek for irrigation purposes has an equal priority to the use therefrom for stockwatering purposes and when the flow of George Creek recedes to a flow of 2.5 c.f.s. at the Lone Rock divider the water cannot be beneficially used for irrigation without being placed on a rotation basis, now, therefore, it is

ORDERED:

1. That the priority of all stockwatering claims from George Creek *from July 1 to Oct 1 inclusive* are reduced to 1884.
2. That during the period of July 1 to October 1, inclusive, when the flow of George Creek recedes to 2.5 c.f.s. it will be placed on a rotation basis.
3. That the period of irrigation shall be from April 1 to October 1.
4. That Water User's Claims Nos. 3, 188, 189, 116, 194, 40, 132, 246, 249, and 248 be increased to a total of 140 head of cattle.

5. That in all other respects the Proposed Determination of
