Dear Dr. Barnes

Re: Beaver River Distribution

The problem of diversion of water under your right, described by Award No. 98 in the Beaver River Decree, has been discussed with me. To clarify the distribution of this right the following directive is issued:

The water to be diverted by you under your award is one second foot. According to the information which I have been able to gather, this water is available at your lower point of diversion most of the time. Apparently you have an upper ditch from which you divert water from the Beaver River when it is available. The water commissioner has been informed to deliver water to your right when it is available at either point of diversion up to one second foot of water in both.

We hope this clarifies the distribution of your water so that there will be no further misunderstanding concerning it.
