



Dear Mr. Lambert:

You will recall our discussions had last spring relative to the matter of the distribution of water to Kent's Lake and Three Creeks. You issued a letter under date of May 28, to the Kent's Lake Reservoir people requiring the installation of proper measuring devices and indicated that there would have to be compliance on the future distribution of the water.

Since the approach of the spring runoff is at hand and we do not intend to again be shortchanged in the water, if we can avoid it, we are calling this matter to your attention now because we understand that there have been no measuring devices installed pursuant to your order and all indications are that the Three Creeks people and the Kent's Lake Reservoir are planning to go ahead as they did last year.

We believe that it would be to the best interest of all concerned if your office would take immediate steps to see that the terms of the decree and distribution agreement are properly enforced this year.

If we can be of any service in connection with the matter, we would be happy to have you call upon us.
