Dear Gerald:

I am writing this letter on behalf of the City Council in regards to the two telephone conversations that you and I have had in the last few months on the Beaver City sprinkler system. It seems that Beaver City is on the growth and that there are areas that are interested in annexing into the City. We are in need of some guidelines and recommendations of how to handle these areas with irrigation water. I will address some specific questions to you and any additional comments or advice you could help us with would be appreciated.

1. In our telephone conversation, we discussed the method of other sources of water being able to be transferred into the city sprinkler system. Such as the Willden Slew (south of beaver), and the Harris-Willis. Could you explain how water needs to physically be able to be in the City pond for distribution. Also, comment on, if an irrigation company such as Harris-Willis does not want their shares transferred out of their company, what their rights are to keep shares in their own distribution system.
2. Explain the process of water stock being transferred from other sources into Beaver City's system. How could this be done?
3. What happens to a water stream such as Shepard or Benson Ditch (both "A" Right), if part of the water is transferred into the City system and the other part is not transferred?

4. Guidelines for the City to use their underground water right in new annexed areas, as irrigation water in sprinkler systems.
5. Can Beaver City annex new areas into the city and supply culinary water for home use only and the homeowner relying on other sources for outside the home use, such as lawns and gardens.
