DEAR MR. MORGAN:

IN RESPONSE TO A TELEPHONE CALL WITH A MEMBER OF YOUR STAFF, MR. LEE SIMMS, THE COUNTY ROAD DRAIN DITCH ASSOCIATION, A MUTUAL ASSOCIATION, IS PETITIONING YOU TO DIVERT THE WATER FROM THE BEAVER RIVER, PRIORITY DATE CLAIMED 1903, AWARD 22, BEAVER RIVER DECREE, AS AMENDED NOVEMBER 27, 1936, FOR IRRIGATION USE FROM APRIL 1 TO OCTOBER 31, BOTH DATES INCLUDED.

OUR UNDERSTANDING IS THAT THE WEIR HAS BEEN CHANGED AND THE WATER CAN NOT BE DIVERTED INTO THE COUNTY ROAD DRAIN. THIS INFORMATION WAS GIVEN TO US BY MR. RONNIE ROBERTS, THE WATER COMMISSIONER FOR THE BEAVER RIVER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM.


IT IS OUR OPINION THAT WHOEVER GAVE THE AUTHORITY TO CHANGE THE FLOW OF THE WEIRS SHOULD PAY TO HAVE THEM SET CORRECTLY AND THAT OUR SHARES OF WATER WILL BE DIVERTED TO THE BEAVER COUNTY DRAIN.


MR. LEE SIMMS, IN A TELEPHONE CONVERSATION WITH MR. RICK COX SAID THAT THE STATE OF UTAH RECOGNIZED OUR WATER RIGHTS, BUT WE WOULD NEED TO HAVE THE PROPERTY AND WATER RIGHT OWNERS SIGN A LETTER BEFORE YOU WOULD HAVE THE COMMISSIONER ACT UPON THIS MATTER.
