The petition of Wayne D. Criddle, the duly appointed and qualified State Engineer of the State of Utah, respectfully represents and shows unto this Honorable Court:

1. That the above entitled cause is the proceeding in which the rights to the use of water from the Provo River and its tributaries were determined and adjudicated; and that in accordance with said adjudication and pursuant to the statute as to consultation with the water users of the Provo River and its tributaries, a water commissioner has been appointed for the Provo River, and the salary of said water commissioner and the other expenses of distribution have been determined and fixed.

2. That the persons hereinafter named are each the owner of rights to the use of the said waters of Provo River, or its tributaries, and each of them have failed, neglected and refused to pay the water assessment levied against them as their proportionate share of the expenses of the Provo River distribution system; and that the names, addresses and amount of delinquency of each said water user is as follows:
