DECLARATION OF WATER RIGHT CLAIMED BY THE

TIMPANOGAS IRRIGATION COMPANY.

Edward Buys, for and on behalf of the Timpanogas Irrigation Company, a corporation, organized and existing under the laws of this State certifies and declares as follows, that is to say:

1. That the Timpanogas Irrigation ^{Company} did on the 23rd day of May A.D. 1895, make a claim to and intend to divert, so soon as necessary ditches and flumes could be with reasonable dilligence completed, for conveying the same, 65 cubic feet per second of the waters of Provo River; said diversion to be made at a point about 15 rods above the Bridge on said river on the County road, in this county, leading from Heber to Park City, Said point of diversion being about 30 rods westerly from the Northeast corner of the North west quarter of Section 6 Township 3 South Rang 5 East, Salt Lake Meridian. Said claim was and is made for the purpose of Irrigating about 2200 acres of land Situated in Sections 6,7,8,17,18, 19, 20, 21, 28, 29, 32, and 33 in Township 3 South, Range 5 five East, and Sections 4, 5, 7, 8, 9, 16 and 17 Township four South, Rang five East Salt Lake Meridian, and in Wasatch County, State of Utah.
2. That the means of diversion by which said waters is to be diverted and the use therefor for irrigation as aforesaid had, is a ditch and flume from said point of diversion and appropriation to the West line of Section 17 township four South, Range five East, Salt Lake Meridian. Said ditch in its course passes through Sections 6, 8, 17, 20, 21, 28 and 33 in said Township 3 South Range 5 East and Sections 4, 3, 10, 9, 16 and 17 Township 4 S. Range 5 East Salt Lake Meridian and in Wasatch County: The dimentions of said ditch and flume as surveyed and partially completed is as follows, Viz Ten feet wide on the Bottom, depth 15 inches in the solid earth on the lower side all excavated dirt ~~earth~~ rock placed upon the lower bank: the banks to be sloped at an angle of Forty five degrees, the fall of said ditch and flume is 1/4 of an inch to the rod
3. That work was commenced upon said ditch and flume on the 23 day of May 1895 and about (2500) Twenty five hundred dollars in labor and money was expended thereon by said Timpanogas Irrigation Company, during the year 1895, and that said company is now dilligently prosecuting the work upon said ditch and flume and the undersigned verily believes that the greater portion thereof will be completed during the year 1897.
