

near the heads of each of the laterals of its stockholders that divert water from City Creek, a proper gate for the control and diversion of its waters ~~waters~~ and a measuring device of such design as shall be approved by the Commissioner in this cause.

And that the said The East River Bottoms Water Company shall immediately provide and hereafter maintain in each of its diversion dams in said City Creek an opening of at least twelve feet in width and the bottom of which shall not be higher than the sill of the lateral gate diverting water near said point, and that said opening shall be at all times hereafter open and free for the passage of water through said City Creek.

And that the said The East River Bottoms Water Company at its own expense and by its supervision shall maintain hereafter that each lateral be closed and maintained dry during all of the time whenever no water is scheduled to be flowing therein.

AND ITS IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this order be served upon an officer of the said The East River Bottoms Water Company.
