For the purpose of correcting certain omissions and errors inadvertently omitted from the "FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW and DECREE" in the above entitled action the following supplemental facts established in the stipulation and trial of said cause are submitted.

1. There has been omitted from Decree, findings and conclusions as to certain rights of the Timpanogus Irrigation Company. See Findings and Conclusions, page 85 (b). and par. 40 page 25
2. Elizabeth Kummer Hamilton, successor to 6 acres of water from midway irrigation company, through its Lower Town Ditch, from the estate of John Junner, deceased, Emma Kummer Bond, administratrix. OMITTED from findings Conclusions and Decree.
3. Alonzo A. Hicken, 10.89 acres-- should be 10.98 acres. See "Decision" page 27; Decree paragraph 72 page 56, also brief and pleadings and stipulation.
4. Joseph Hatch should have decreed to him 20 acres of water from Wasatch Irrigation Company for lands situated in Green Farm lying east of Heber, and also water for 1 city lot in Heber City.
5. Emma Wherritt should have water for one city lot in Heber City decreed to her from wasatch Irrigation Company.

The acreage above referred to in Par. 4 and 5, was included within the total acreage given to the Wasatch Irrigation Company, according to the testimony of John H. Clegg, but hatch and wherritt are entitled to a decree, decreeing that water to them, otherwise they have no claim against the wasatch Irrigation Company and cannot enforce their claims.
