That the Proposed Decree be modified by substituting for sub-division (m), paragraph 97, page -64-, the following:

Mary Hamilton Chambers,  
Maggie Hamilton Campbell,  
Theodore Hamilton, and

stituted for James B. Hamilton, 1st 33 .550  
deceased; Jointly and undivided, 17th .275 "

That the Proposed Findings and the Proposed Decree be each modified by adding in the captions thereof, the names of these defendants, James A. Hamilton, William Hamilton, Ella Hamilton Snyder, Jennie Hamilton Summers, Lovica Hamilton Snyder, Mary Hamilton Chambers, Maggie Hamilton Campbell, Theodore Hamilton, and David Hamilton.
