To the Honorable District Court:

The petition of Ernest A. White, John Swift, L. H. Bisel, John W. Lefler, E. B. Lefler, W. Moon, Hyrum Moon, Marshall Lefler, and Frank Turnbow, respectfully shows, that they are residents in ^{Summit County} and under the Provo River system; that they are some of the defendants in the above entitled case now pending in this Honorable Court and are within the jurisdiction of this Court; that it becomes necessary for them to have the culinary use of the water of Provo river during the ensuing summer and pending the disposition of the case now before this Honorable Court; that a failure to grant the petition herein prayed for would work great hardship upon the petitioners herein; that your petitioners herein pray that the order heretofore made in the above entitled cause be amended to the extent that the undersigned be granted one-half second foot of water to be taken from the Provo river through that certain artificial ^{course} water, known as the Phillips ditch at the point where water is now appropriated for said ditch, an amount equal to one-half second foot of water to be used by the undersigned, for culinary purposes only and for no other purpose; that these petitioners

be given the right to appropriate for this season or until the above cause is determined, the said amount of one-half second foot of water and that so much of the said one-half second foot of water as shall not be put to culinary use, be returned to the Provo river; that this one-half second foot of water herein prayed for be in addition to the present amount claimed under the existing order made by this Honorable Court.
