T.F.Wentz, the Commissioner of this Court in the above entitled cause, having filed his petition in this Court and cause, from which it appears that two sets of timber gates leading from the Tailrace of the Olmstead Plant of the Utah Power & Light Company to the Provo River, are decayed and worn out and should be replaced before the highwater period of 1922. That such replacement should be of structures of concrete and steel. That the most opportune time to make such instalation is within the next sixty days. And from which it further appears that none of the parties to this action, acknowledge themselves responsible for the payment of the cost of the same, or any fixed portion thereof, and that it is necessary that an order of this Court be made binding upon the parties and fixing and determining which of the parties shall pay the said costs, or whether same shall be assessed against all of the parties in some fixed proportion and if so what such proportion shall be, it is therefore:

ORDERED, that the 26th day of September A.D. 1921, at the Court-house at Provo City, Utah, at 10⁴⁶ clock a.m. be and the same is hereby fixed as the time and place of hearing upon said petition, and that at said time and place the parties named in said petition shall appear and show cause, if any they have, why an order should not be made having the force and effect of a judgement requiring any or all of said parties to pay the amount of such costs in such proportion and in such sums and at such times as the Court, after said hearing, may deem just and proper.

AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that a copy of this order and a copy of said petition be served upon the attorneys or attorney of said parties, and upon the parties not represented by attorney, at least five days before the date of said hearing.
