

Cottonwood Creek  
River Commissioner Operation Criteria

The agreement between Emery Water Conservancy District and Cottonwood Creek Consolidated Irrigation Company, which employs the District to operate and maintain the company's piped systems, is further clarified in reference to the distribution of the water from Joes Valley Reservoir to the downstream users as follows:

The District operates Joes Valley Reservoir under contract between USBOR and CCCIC. Those releases will be further regulated by the District into all of the diversions below the reservoir. These diversions will include the Peacock Ditch, CVSSD/CCCIC Stock Water, Johnson Ditch, Adobe Wash Reservoir, Swasey Ditch, Mammoth Canal, Cottonwood Pump Station, Blue Cut Canal, Mill Ditch, Wilberg Ditch, Willsonville Ditch.

The District will hold weekly meetings with the water masters of these canals and ditches to obtain water orders for the ensuing week. Releases will be made from Joes Valley Reservoir to satisfy these water orders. The District will record the daily diversions at all of the above points. The District will prepare a yearend report which includes the record of diversions and other pertinent information concerning the water year.

The Irrigation Company will regulate all diversions above the Joes Valley Reservoir. A water master will record the daily water amount delivered into the following diversions: Upper Joes Valley, Indian Creek, Black Canyon, Olsen Ditch, Reeder Subdivisions, Verde Ditch, Fillmore Ditch, Various pumps and wells, and Swasey/Fuller Creek.

The Company will distribute the water in its canals. The water masters will record the individual water use from its pipelines and canals. The Company will supply it's records to the District at the end of the year for compilation of the final report.
