Enclosed is a Draft 2016 Water Use Plan (Plan), based on our latest database review. Please review the Draft Plan and make any necessary updates/corrections. Following are some recommendations on how to update your Plan:

- Identify any new water rights or changes in contracts that are omitted.
- Identify or describe any new points of diversion (PODs), measuring devices, and/or conveyance facilities (ditches, pipelines, etc.)
- Identify any new or unlisted water supply contracts, suppliers, amount of contract (ac-ft), contract number, water rights, change or exchange numbers, POD locations, etc.
- Identify any other notable changes or updates that apply.

Your Use Plan enables the Weber River Distribution System to operate properly and according to water right priorities under the direction of the Weber River Commissioner and the State Engineer. The Plan does not necessarily identify all applicable limits associated with each water right. However, all water right limits must be considered, evaluated, and reflected in the Plan. Such limitations may include ownership of water rights, quantity of surface water or groundwater, Point of Diversion (POD) locations, contract limits, source, type of use, place of use, priority date, etc.

Water diversions are measured, monitored, and reported by source and POD location by the Weber River Water Commissioner under the direction of the State Engineer's Office. Maintaining measuring devices and exchange contracts are the water users' responsibilities. **If a measuring device is not working properly, please promptly repair or replace it.** Annual totals at each point of diversion are reported in the annual Weber River Commissioner's Report.

If your water rights or contracts change during the year, updates must be submitted to enable a review of the water right sources, uses, quantities, PODs, etc. The updated Plan should identify applicable changes before water is diverted, measured, and/or reported.

With the exception of a small portion remaining under 35-8240, all other water moved to Quarry Mountain or was placed under nonuse. Mr. Clissold will update the plan if or when use begins again.
Surface Diversion # 1 N 1854 ft W 749 ft from SE cor, Sec 31, T 1S, R 4E, SLBM A change application is necessary to update the place of use and POD if it is anything other than what is already approved.

1. The original 35-8240 had 4 Surface PODs. It appears the actual POD being used is Number 1 listed on the water right. The actual diversion is on McLeod Creek, at the splitter diversion structure at the head of Quarry Mountain Ranches with a pipeline to the pond near the side of the mountain at the Clissold Home.
2. Surface water use must remain within the limits outlined above. Diversions may be cut (shut off) by the water commissioner based on water supply and priority dates.
3. This plan was updated to reflect the status of these water rights as described in the water right database. All database data must be verified.
4. The total amount of water used under valid water rights must not exceed the quantity available for use under the base water rights prior to any segregations or changes.

Diversion #2 is the point nearest the actual diversion structure. All HOA irrigation water is diverted at Diversion 2 into a ditch that flows to the ponds.

State Law requires a headgate and weir (or flume) at Diversion #2, and any other diversion being used to divert HOA water. The others PODs are not used.

The 2016 Use Plan was updated based on a field inspection held in 2015. The HOA pipeline meter, if installed, will help monitor company use, not the diversion.

The measurement at the head of the ditch will also include some water passing downstream during snowmelt season, so it is not used to compute total ac-ft. The pipeline meter helps limit the total use to 355.7 ac-ft less 6 ac-ft pond evaporation, which is 349.7 ac-ft maximum quantity pumped into the pipeline each year.

1. The original water right and all use outlined above is surface water use. The surface PODs were changed under a36389.
