## Electronic Meeting Statement

The holding of a meeting in person at an anchor location presents a substantial risk to the health and safety of those who may be present due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. Public meetings held by the State Engineer regarding the adjudication of water rights in the past have drawn large audiences. Current guidelines from the Governor's Office recommend limiting large gatherings and encourage working remotely whenever feasible. Therefore, the State Engineer determines that holding this meeting through electronic means without an anchor location will best serve the State of Utah's efforts to combat COVID-19 while still allowing interested members of the public to participate in proceedings.

#### NOTICE TO WATER USERS WITHIN THE ABOVE-DESCRIBED DRAINAGE AREA:

This is the List of Unclaimed Rights of Record for the Provo River Division, Midway Subdivision, Area No. 55, Book 10. Jordan River General Adjudication. The Division of Water Rights has prepared this List of Unclaimed Rights of Record as § 73-4-9.5. The List of Unclaimed Rights of Record lists each water right of record in the State Engineer's office for which a not timely filed. A copy of the List of Unclaimed Rights of Record has been filed with the Clerk of the Third District Court in Salt Lake City, Utah. Printed copies are available, upon payment of printing costs, from the Division of Water Rights at 1594 W. North Temple, Suite 220, Salt Lake City, Utah, telephone, (801) 538-7240. An electronic copy in PDF is also available for download free of charge from the website of the Division of Water Rights at www.waterrights.utah.gov.

You are hereby notified that under Utah Code § 73-4-9.5(2), any person claiming a water right in the Midway Subdivision who is dissatisfied with the List of Unclaimed Rights of Record may object to it in accordance with the requirements set by statute. The subject of an objection to the List of Unclaimed Rights of Record is limited to inclusion of a water right in the List. To object, the claimant must file both a written objection and a statement of claim (i.e., water user's claim) in the Third Judicial District Court, 450 South State Street, P.O. Box 1860, Salt Lake City, Utah 84114, within ninety (90) days after being served with notice of completion of the List of Unclaimed Rights of Record. Service is effective on the date the notice is mailed (or hand delivered) to the claimant or is published. The claimant must also file a statement of claim with, and should send a copy of the objection to, the State Engineer by sending them to counsel for the State Engineer at the address shown below.

## List of Unclaimed Rights Preamble

#### Relevant Prior Decrees

of Unclaimed Rights of Record on each identified potential claimant that was served with a summons, as required by Utah Code § 73-4-9.5(1)(b). The List of Unclaimed Rights of Record is available on the Division of water signs website at <a href="https://www.waterrights.utah.gov">www.waterrights.utah.gov</a> for of charge.

- 4. Failure to Timely File a Claim Where a potential claimant has failed to timely file a Statement of Water Users Claim and that failure is not excused by the Court, the claimant is forever based and estopped from asserting his or her right to the use of water.
- 5. Historical Decrees. Prior to the publication of this List of Unclaimed

rights awarded in the decrees listed below:

Provo River Decree - Provo Reservoir Co. v. Provo City, Civil No. 2888, (Utah 4th Dist. Ct. May 2, 1921) (the "Provo River Decree").

If the List of Unclaimed Rights of Record includes any decree awards for which a timely statement of claim was not filed, the corresponding paragraph of the decree is listed in parentheses next to the owner(s) of record's name(s). Where accurate points of diversion could not be identified from the description the respective decree, the State Engineer has attempted to describe the Section, Township, and Range within which the point of diversion is located.

- 6. State Engineer's Recommendation. The State Engineer is recommending that the Court adjudge the rights included in this List of Unclaimed Rights of Record abandoned.
- Continued Assistance. The State Engineer and the staff of the Division of Water Rights express their continuing willingness to assist the Court in this General Adjudication, as the Court requests.
- 8. Date of Publication. This List of Unclaimed Rights of Record was approved for publication on the 17th day of March, 2021.

Teresa Wilhelmsen, P.E., State Engineer of the State of Utah, respectfully submits this List of Unclaimed Rights of Record to the Court.

- 1. Geographical Area Covered. This General Adjudication, known as the Utah Lake and Jordan River General Adjudication, includes all water sources, both surface and underground, within the drainage of the Utah Lake and Jordan River in Utah, Salt Lake, Davis, Summit, Wasatch, Sanpete, and Juab Counties in Utah. This List of Unclaimed Rights of Record is limited to water rights with points of diversion in the Midway Subdivision of the Provo River Division of the Utah Lake and Jordan River General Adjudication. The Midway Subdivision is the enlarged area on the map shown on page v. The Utah Division of Water Rights has designated the subdivision for this area as Area 55. Book 10 (or 55-10).
- 2. Commencement. On September 1, 1944, the Court ordered the State Engineer to make a determination and adjudication of all rights to the use of water of Utah Lake and Jordan River and their tributaries in Utah and Salt Lake Counties. On June 21, 1972, the Court issued an order clarifying that the adjudication area includes all the rights to the use of water, both surface and

underground, within the drainage area of Utah Lake and Jordan River and their tributaries in Utah, Salt Lake, Davis, Summit, Wasatch, Sanpete, and Juab Counties

The June 21, 1972 order also ordered that the title of this action be amended to read, "In the Matter of the General Determination of the Rights to the Use of all of the Water, Both Surface and Underground, Within the Drainage Area of Utah Lake and Jordan River in Utah, Salt Lake, Davis, Summit. Wasatch, Sanpete and Juab Counties in Utah."

3. State Engineer's Activity. The State Engineer has followed the requirements of Title 73, Chapter 4 of the Utah Code. She has given the required notices, served and published summons, completed hydrographic surveys, and taken claims from water users within the area. The State Engineer has searched the files of the Division of Water Rights prior to making the recommendations in the List of Unclaimed Rights of Record. To the best knowledge of the State Engineer, this List of Unclaimed Rights of Record contains all rights of record for which a Statement of Water User's Claim was not timely filed. The State Engineer has prepared and served notice of the List




## Provo Canyon (55-9) List of Unclaimed Rights


