Dear Mr. Jones, re: Water applications to Pine, Wah Wah & Hamlin Valleys.

When all the (USGS, etc.) studies are done there will still be a Shortage in these basins! I.M.H.O. the only thing to do is Reject BOTH Applications from Iron Cnty (CICWCD) & Beaver Cnty because the water is Over allocated! And, "maybe" allow them to reapply (for a Much more modest amount) at some future date. Following the Beryl Enterprise management plan may be appropriate here.

In the Meantime the Ranchers, farmers & businesses that Already HAVE established water rights, will be protected from intrusion by CICWCD & Beaver Cnty both of whom (in effect) may be usurping these rights!!
